

DIRECTIONS TO THE OFFICES OF THE SYNOD OF THE WESTERN CAPE (“NG KERKSENTRUM”)

FROM THE N1

(DRIVING FROM EITHER CAPE TOWN OR PAARL)

Take the off-ramp indicating Van Schoor Ave/Durban Road – the usual turn off for the Tyger Valley Shopping Centre. Proceed in a southerly direction – towards Bellville City Centre – away from Durbanville. After leaving the intersection of the N1, drive through three (3) sets of traffic lights. After the third one, proceed straight forward, with eventually the huge Telkom-Building on your left-hand side. At the fourth (4) traffic light (which is the intersection with De Lange Street), turn left. A crossing follows virtually immediately. On your right-hand side you’ll see a fenced public parking area. After the crossing, the synodical building is on your left-hand side, second from the corner (across from the parking area) with “NG Kerkentrum” visible on the side.

There is a limited number of parking spaces indicated in front of the building. If all the parking has been taken, you are welcome to drive around the building to the other side, where more parking, as well as the main entrance to the building, is available in Pastorie Street.

FROM CAPE TOWN AIRPORT

Take Robert Sobukwe Road (direction Bellville). Turn right into Robert Sobukwe Road and stay on this road (direction Bellville), passing the University of Western Cape (UWC) on your right. Turn left at the traffic light following UWC, still in Robert Sobukwe Road. Carry on straight and pass Bellville Stadion (on your left). Cross Voortrekker Street into Vlei Street. Turn left at the first traffic light into De Lange Street. The synodical building, clearly marked “NG Kerkentrum”, is the third building on your left hand side (5 De Lange Street) just after the Bellville Dutch Reformed Church building.

Parking is available in front of the building. If all the parking has been taken, you are welcome to drive around the building to the other side, where more parking, as well as the main entrance to the building, is available in Pastorie Street.
