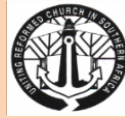

"It is true that words such as reconciliation and forgiveness taken from the Bible and made applicable to politics can become a powerful means of radical transformation. But as we have discovered in South Africa, they can also become no more than political pietism-in other words, not as a critique of the political process, but turned into a handmaiden of it and subservient to the demands of expediency, divorced from those realities that make true reconciliation possible, durable and sustainable: confrontation with evil rather than papering over the cracks; repentance, remorse, forgiveness, restitution and reciprocity of social, distributive justice as the only response to the scale and depth of political, communal and personal forgiveness white South Africans were offered by blacks in our reconciliation efforts" (Allan Boesak in ,Radical Reconciliation)
